1. ASTM/SEI approved helmets must be worn by anyone jumping. ASTM/SEI approved helmets are encouraged for all riders at all times while mounted and rider safety equipment (including protective vests) will not penalized in any class.
2. Cross entry between beginner horse/pony and beginner rider divisions is not permitted.
3. VA department of Agriculture requires all horses on the show grounds have a current (within 12 months) negative coggins.
4. BRHF and/or FCEC membership is not required to compete in any class.
5. Dogs must be on a leash at all times.
6. The Roanoke Valley Horsemen's Association, Green Hill Park Equestrian Center, Blue Ridge Horse Force, Franklin County Equestrian, show management, any members, families, organizers, volunteers, property owners or employees, assume no responsibility in case of loss, injury, or damage to persons, horses or personal property for any cause and admittance, and entries are accepted only on this basis.
