RULES:

- The show will be run according to FCEC and BRHF Rules.
- All riders are encouraged to wear an approved ATSM helmet however; all riders under 18 years old must wear a helmet while mounted. Parents/Guardian are responsible to ensure helmet meets standards.
- The show is open to the public – you do not need to be a FCEC or BRHF member, however FCEC and BRHF guidelines will be followed.
- Negative Coggins within twelve (12) months must be provided.
- Show management reserves the right to add, cancel or combine classes.
- When three (3) or less in a class Youth & Adult will be combined.
- FCEC members will be issued back numbers beginning with 8000 and shall be worn by the declared horse/rider combination at all FCEC shows/sanctioned shows. With the exception of any horse/rider combination(s) that have been declared BRHF member would default to the BRHF back number.
- Goodwill and sportsmanship are essential for a fun and safe show, management reserves the right to bar any animal, exhibitor, owner, or spectator for inappropriate behavior.
- Appropriate Show Attire is encouraged (No tank tops, strapless shirts or shorts allowed).
- Neither leadership, or any affiliate of Franklin County Equestrian Club (FCEC) nor any of its members, families, organizers, property owners, nor employees shall be held responsible for accident, damage, injury, illness or loss to the animals, personal property, exhibitors, spectators or any other persons on the show grounds.
- A two (2) minute gate call and five (5) minute tack change will be enforced.
- Membership must be in place before points will accumulate for Year End Awards. For membership information email: www.franklincountyequestrianclub@yahoo.com.
- No ground tying.
- No umbrellas, balls, blankets and/or any other objects on or near the rail. No leading or climbing on rail.
- Stallions must be controlled by an adult at all times.
- In case of inclement weather call contact number below prior to the show and/or check FCEC website at FranklinCountyEquestrianClub.com or FCEC's Facebook page.
- Alcohol is prohibited.
- All scratches and adds to classes MUST be made three (3) classes prior, no exceptions. There will be no cash refunds – an even exchange for additional class added given. Unless horse or rider are deemed not able to continue show by Show Management.
- No dogs are allowed.
- Judges decision is final.

English – 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29	*Division (English, Hunter, Ranch or Western) to be declared by rider prior to the beginning of the show for Championship placings.
Gaited – 30, 31, 32	*Division (English or Western) to be declared by rider prior to the beginning of the show for Championship placings.
Gymkhana – 42, 43, 44, 45, 46, 47, 48, 49, 50, 51	
Hunter – 33, 34, 35, 36, 37, 38, 39, 40, 41	
Ranch – 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20	**Same horse/rider combination cannot cross enter into Western Pleasure Division – No bling.
Western Pleasure – 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12	***Same horse/rider combination cannot cross enter into Ranch Division.

Directions to Spring Valley Farm:

From Roanoke, VA:

Take 24 West for approximately 12 miles.

Turn right on State Route 608 (Emmaus Church Rd). Continue for approx. one mile.

Turn right onto State Route 757 (Goodview Town Rd). Continue for approx. one mile.

Spring Valley Farm will be on your right.

From Rocky Mount, VA:

Take VA-122 North for approx. 20 miles.

Turn left onto State Route 655 (Diamond Hill Road). There is a stoplight there and once you turn, there will be a Dollar General on your left and a Food Lion on your right.

Continue for approx. four miles.

Turn right onto State Route 616 (Horseshoe Bend Road). There will be a gas station on your left before you turn. Continue for approx. two miles.

Spring Valley Farm will be on your left.

From Bedford, VA:

Take VA-122 South for approx. five miles.

Turn right onto VA-24 West. Continue for approx. one mile.

Turn left onto VA-749 (Meadors Spur Road). Continue for approx. one mile.

Turn right onto State Route 608 (Emmaus Church Rd). Continue for approx. a half mile.

Turn left onto State Route 757 (Goodview Town Rd). Continue for approx. one mile.

Spring Valley Farm will be on your right.
